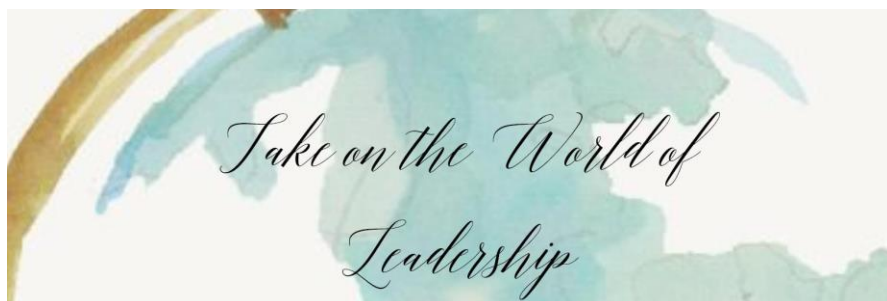


# CENTER FOR ETHICAL LEADERSHIP
